Please Note: The following scriptural citations are still NOT an exhaustive list of <u>every</u> scripture that supports the **Zion's Roar Ministries**, "**Statement of Faith.**" Frankly there are MANY more, but that would include nearly the entire Bible. However, enough verses ARE included in the various parenthesis below to convey the scriptural foundation for our views. The "Statement of Faith" on our webpage excludes these numerous citations solely to enhance readability and understanding for those readers that may be new to the Word of G-d.

Statement of Faith: "I believe with perfect faith that G-d created the heavens and earth (GENESIS 1:1); that He created man in His own image and woman from that image (GENESIS 1:26-27; 2:22); that both man and woman fell from their lofty position through disobedience (GENESIS 3:1-12); the woman deceived by an already fallen Satan (1 TIMOTHY 2:14; EZEKIEL 28:13-19; ISAIAH 14:12-17; JEREMIAH 4:23-28), the man through love for the woman, choosing to join her in her fallen state (ROMANS 5:14; GENESIS 1:26, 2:24; 1 JOHN 4:8; EPHESIANS 5:25) and thus, they and their line were both corrupted by sin unto death (GENESIS 2:17; ROMANS 6:23); that G-d loved mankind and promised a Redeemer to restore them (GENESIS 3:15; JOHN 3:16; 1 CORINTHIANS 15:22), but not the Fallen Angels (HEBREWS 2:5,16; 2 PETER 2:4; JUDE 1:6), based on Adam's motivations of pure love (GENESIS 1:26; 1 JOHN 4:8; JOHN 3:16; EPHESIANS 5:25) vs. Satan's motive of pride and rebellion (PROVERBS 8:13, 16:18; EZEKIEL 28:13-19; ISAIAH 14:12-15; 1 TIMOTHY 3:6); that G-d entered into covenant with Abraham (GENESIS 12:1-3, 15:1-6; 17:7; 22:16-18); Isaac (GENESIS 17:19-21); and Jacob (GENESIS 28:13-15; 32:28; 35:10-12) to bring that Redeemer through their lineage for the redemption and blessing of mankind (GENESIS 18:18; 22:18; 26:4; 49:9-10; GALATIANS 3:8), and that He made other material promises to them as well, including all the Land of Israel forever (GENESIS 12:7; 13:14-17; 15:7,18; 17:8, 24:7; 28:1-4; 35:12; 48:4); that He appeared to Moses (EXODUS 3:1-6+; 6:2-4, 8); and presented the perfect Torah (EXODUS 19-20+; 31:18; PSALM 19:7) in the company of angels (ACTS 7:53; GALATIANS 3:19; HEBREWS 2:2) as a pattern for things to come (EXODUS 25:9; HEBREWS 8:5); and to instruct man in righteousness (ROMANS; 7:7; 15:4); yet also to show that man in his sinful condition was unable to fully keep Torah to restore himself (ROMANS 3:20; 7:14, 18; 24, GALATIANS 2:16); that G-d further promised King David that the Redeemer would be born of his descendants and would rule as King of Israel (PSALM 89:35-36); that in the fullness of time (MARK 1:15; GALATIANS 4:4), that Redeemer, Jesus Christ (Yeshua Ha'Meshiach), (MATTHEW 1:21; LUKE 1:31-33) the eternal and divine Son of G-d (PSALMS 2:2; PROVERBS 30:4; MATTHEW 14:33; 16:16; 26:63-64; 27:43, 54; MARK 1:1; 15:39; LUKE 1:32, 35, JOHN 1:34, 49; ACTS 8:37; 9:20; ROMANS 1:4; 2 CORINTHIANS 1:19; GALATIANS 2:20; HEBREWS 4:14; 1 JOHN 3:8; 5:1+), was sent forth and was supernaturally born, fully human (DANIEL 7:13-14; LUKE 22:69; JOHN 1:51; 5:25; 6:69; 9:35; 11:4; 20:31; ACTS 3:13, 26, ACTS 7:56); that he was born of a virgin (ISAIAH 7:14; LUKE 1:27); thus pure, He lived a sinless life (HEBREWS 4:15; MATTHEW 27:24), but chose to be crucified on man's (my) behalf (JOHN 10:18) as the infinite final sacrifice for man's (my) finite sins which He took upon Himself; that He was raised





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from the dead (MATTHEW 17:23; LUKE 9:22; JOHN 10:18; ACTS 2:24, 32) because His sacrifice was approved and accepted by the Father (ACTS 2:24, 32; 3:15, 26; 4:10; 5:30; 10:40; 13:30, 33, 34, 37; 17:31; ROMANS 4:24-25; 6:4; 7:4; 8:11; 10:9; GALATIANS 1:1; EPHESIANS 1:20; 2:6; COLOSSIANS 2:12); and because He Himself was yet blameless; that He ascended to return to Heaven, and is currently seated at the right hand of G-d the Father (MARK 16:19; LUKE 22:69; ACTS 7:55-56; ROMANS 8:34; COLOSSIANS 3:1; HEBREWS 10:12; 1 PETER 3:22) awaiting the full number of Gentile believers (ISAIAH 11:10; 42:6; 60:3,5: 62:2; MALACHI 1:11; MATTHEW 4:14-17; 12:21; LUKE 2:32; ACTS 9:15; 10:45; 11:1; 15:14, 17; 22:21; 26:17, 23, 28; ROMANS 3:29; 9:24, 30; 11:1, 25; 15:12; GALATIANS 3:14; EPHESIANS 3:6); who will join a fewer number of past and current Jewish believers (JOHN 8:31; 11:45; 12:11, 42; ACTS 14:1; 15:5; 21:20; ROMANS 15:10-11; 1 **CORINTHIANS 12:23)**, that have lay claim to His redemption; that He will call us and His righteous dead together to Him (ROMANS 6:8; 8:11; 1 CORINTHIANS 15:42; 1 THESSALONIANS 1:10); that as we are caught up to meet Him in the air (1 THESSALONIANS 4:16-17), we will be bodily transformed and restored to man's former immortal glory (GENESIS 1:26; 1 CORINTHIANS 15:52) and then rewarded (or not) for our works performed while in this fallen form (2 CORINTHIANS 5:10); that we will be with Him for all eternity, but we will first await the full reconciliation of Israel (PSALM 27:5; 32:7; 37:39; 41:1; PROVERBS 11:8); that in their time of trouble (ISAIAH: 33:2; JEREMIAH 30:7; DANIEL 12:1), the Jewish veil will be removed (2 CORINTHIANS 3:13-16), and they will recognize Him whom they have scorned (ZECHARIAH 12:10); that in deep anguish they will call upon Him, and that He will hear their cry (PSALM 20:1; 50:15; 86:17; 102:2) and return to save them from their enemies (PSALM 54:7; 59:16; 107:6,13,19;) and their sins (PSALM 25:22), and thus, all Israel shall be saved (NAHUM 1:7; ISAIAH 45:17; JEREMIAH 23:6; ACTS 5:31; ROMANS 11:26); that He will reign 1,000 years as the promised King Messiah, the Son of David, from an earthly Jerusalem (REVELATION 20); that after 1,000 years, Satan will lead a final revolt against His rule (REVELATION 20); that He will immediately quash this revolt, raise the unjust dead, and with the surviving rebels, judge them all together with Satan and his angels (REVELATION 20); that they will all be sentenced to the eternal fires and torments of Hell forever (REVELATION 20); and that He will purify this current creation through obliteration by fire (PSALM 75:2-3; 2 PETER 3:10-12), before creating a new heaven and a new earth wherein dwells only righteousness forevermore (REVELATION 21); that all these things have been revealed to His servants the prophets (AMOS 3:7), and can be proven from their inerrant record of past fulfillment-to-date (MATTHEW 8:17; 12:17; 13:35; 21:4; 26:4,56; 27:9,35; Acts 3:18) as reliable predicates for the future (MATTHEW 5:18; 24:34); in which, every knee shall bow and every tongue shall confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of G-d the Father, forever and ever (ISAIAH 45:23; ROMANS 14:11; PHILIPPIANS 2:10-11).
