COMPARING THE JEWISH TANAKH WITH THE CHRISTIAN OLD TESTAMENT:

The Jewish Tanakh and the Christian Old Testament are identical in material, but differ in book structure and order. Whereas there are 39 distinct books in the Christian Old Testament, there are only 24 in the Jewish Tanakh due to the consolidation of some books, separated in the Christian Old Testament.
